## **B. AVALON MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE -**

- \* Jane S is working on a poster for the front hall, 11x17 with weekly or bi-weekly events. Date and location in the Avalon will be color-coded.

### 3. OLD BUSINESS, International Festival Review

#### A. INT FEST SUMMARY -

The Festival made a profit of \$45.00 this year. The Board of Directors had agreed to a loss of up to \$1,000, so this was a nice profit. See attached financial summary.

- \* Booths did well, fewer booths but slightly higher price.
- \* Had some slight trouble with city authorized food vendors, but worked out.
- \* Daily Camera did not have much publicity.
- \* We made the highest amount of "fish bowl" donations with the inclusion of a private donation of \$200 from Barbara Roach.
- \* We have a very positive relationship with city offices and county.
- \* We have excellent connection with many of the performing groups.

#### B. CURRENT QUESTIONS about the Festival

- \* Is this still connected with all of VAC?
- \* Not a whole community effort
- \* Not a profit for the VAC
- \* Should all performing groups be members? Should we ask them to join?

Could end up with a number of groups not coming to the annual meeting, making a quorum impossible to obtain.

\* The majority of the volunteers come from the same group (BIFD) and are the same people from year to year. Need to make a whole community effort.

### C. IDEAS for next year

- 1. Festival Committee must be active and meet with Jim S to help plan festival.
- 2. Daily Camera needs to do a better ad and cover the event itself. Photographers?
- 3. KGNU
- 4. Non-member supporting groups for \$25 for the performing groups if wished "Friends of the Avalon"
- 5. Promote Avalon and Boulder Dance more at the festival.
- 6. Have a \$5/ off coupon available to new dancers at the festival. Good for \$5 off specific dances at the Avalon. Would give us an idea of how effective we were in bringing in new people to the Avalon.
- 7. Consensus of this group meeting tonight is to continue the festival (5 for, 1 abstain). This is only a suggestion and not a binding decision.

## D. NEXT YEAR June 19,20,21, 2014

- \* Must have a truck with a lift gate, Must have someone to drive it not the Stepaneks.
- \* Hire workers to load and unload stage and heavy cabinets, or have the in-kind Fuseboxe come and do the work.
- \* Look for other grants-Bill will think about this.

- \* We all like the font and placement for The Avalon sign, and the slogan "where dancers meet".
- \* We feel that the last two lines should be left for a sign over the door and not the parking lot sign. (Website and BDC)
- \* We would like to see the dancers more filled in (heavier lines, bolder to be visible from the road) and a bit more abstract. Larry has a good pair of abstracts and will check on the copyright.

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#### 4. NEW BUSINESS

#### A. First of Fall Dance, re-visit

It was suggested that we have an all Avalon dance/international bazaar on the lawn outside the Avalon with a dance floor, food trucks and member vendors.
