

An Update On VAC Activities

Now is a time to acknowledge accomplishments and several positive changes in the operation of the Village Arts Coalition (VAC). This umbrella organization was started nearly two decades ago for the purpose of strengthening the participatory dance community along the Colorado Front Range. Some of the most important achievements and current activities of VAC are:

The VAC International Festival

This summer's eleventh successful International Festival was held on the Pearl Street Mall. The first festival was held in 1986 in front of the library and was a part of the Boulder Creek Festival for several years. This event has become a popular addition to the summer activities in downtown Boulder. The VAC is seeking a new coordinator for next year's festival. The Pearl Street Studio

One of the most significant VAC achievements in the early years was leasing the dance studio at 2126 Pearl in 1991. In 1998 when the owner wanted to sell the building and possibly close the dance studio, VAC became the largest investor in the Folk Dancers Investor Group, LLC (FDIG), the group that bought the building to preserve the dance studio for the dance community. Several dance groups have made the Pearl Street Studio their home over the past 16 years.

Insurance Program

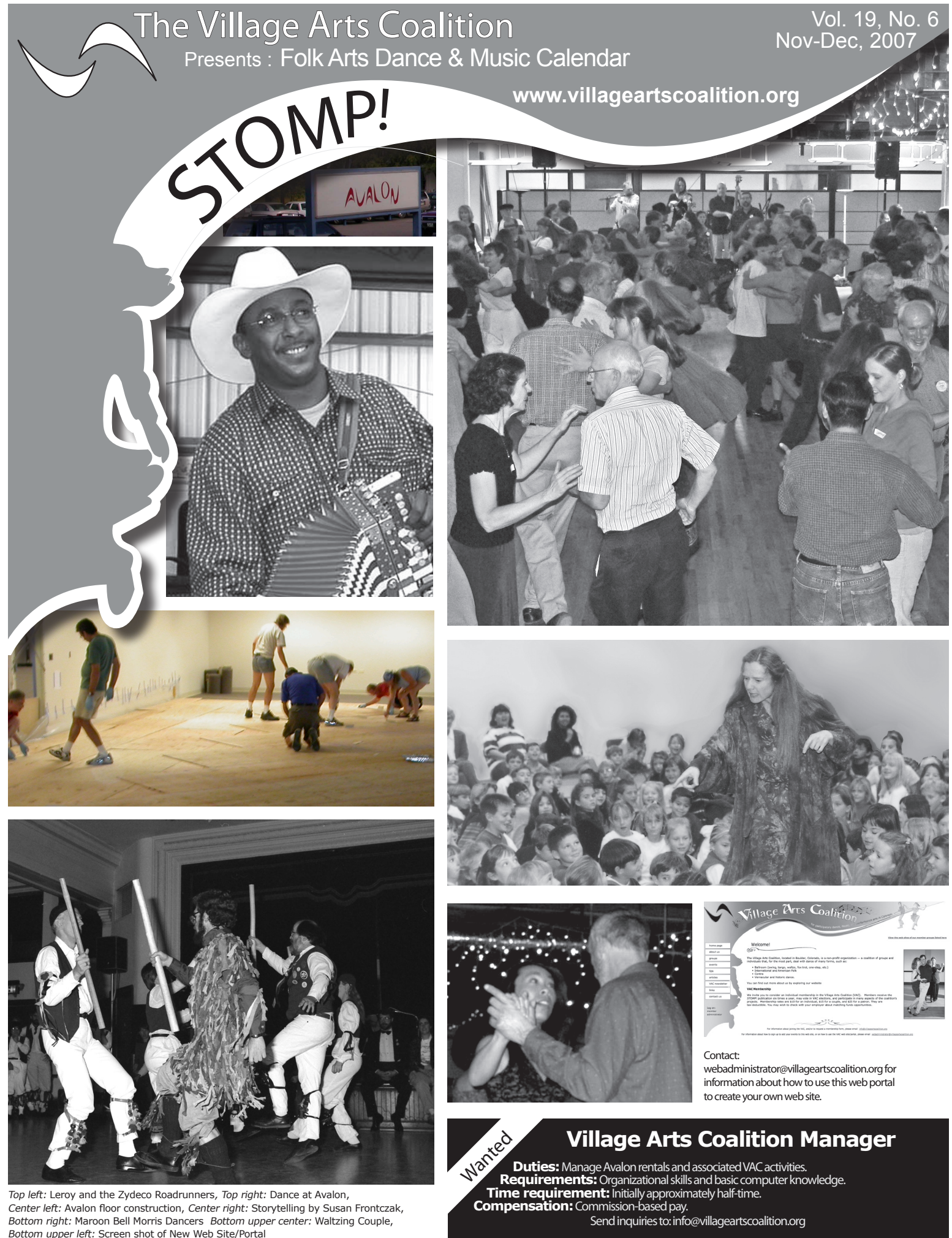

VAC Website

A new VAC website has been created which will serve as a web portal for member groups to enter their information and activities. This website will serve as a directory of dance, music, and other performing arts activities in the area for participants and observers, and offers members a place to advertise their activities. Those groups who currently have no web presence may easily create their own web page using this portal. This page will give them, as well as VAC member groups who currently have their own website, an opportunity to summarize all of their activities on the VAC website. Members can also provide a link back to their main website if desired. Each member will have its own login name and password and will be solely responsible for the content of its page. A test logon is available, if desired, to see how the new portal works for member groups.

The Avalon

Since the first dance in October of 2005, Avalon has become the home for many dance events, birthday parties and weddings. The online scheduling calendar, at <http://www.boulderdancespace.com>, indicates that nearly every evening of the week is now filled with various kinds of dancing. VAC is a partner in Boulder Dance, LLC, the owner of 6185 Arapahoe, and VAC operates the nearly 5,000 square foot Avalon ballroom in his building. Future expansions include two additional dance studios adjacent to the ballroom, one approx. 2,300 square feet and a second one of approx. 900 square feet. More than 18,000 volunteer hours have been contributed so far in building this facility, including laying the sprung oak floor in the ballroom. It is rewarding for everyone who has been involved in the building of this facility that we have now reached the point where the rental income allows us to hire a part-time manager to schedule rentals and to oversee the operation of Avalon. This is presently a half time position which will grow to full time when the two additional dance studios are built and the ballroom is completed.
