

Stanley G. Wilkes is an uncommon leader in the Denver/Boulder participatory dance community. Many recognize Stan as a frequent participant at folkdances, contradances and special events. Fewer realize he has worked tirelessly behind the scenes and is a founding individual of several dance endeavors in our Denver/Boulder folk arts community. Stan was born in Burbank, California. Stan earned engineering degrees at Caltech and Stanford, and took up square dancing. During his early adult years Stan played guitar, sang folk songs and called singing square dances.

Stan moved to Colorado in 1969. He studied accounting at CU, took a masters degree, subsequently joined an accounting firm, and contra dancing became his main dance. Stan revived the CFOOTMAD tax-exempt status, was the Treasurer for many years, and participated in the creation of the Board of Directors.

In 1989 Bonny Askew and friends had founded the Village Arts Coalition. Stan attended a meeting with others to help her set up a Board of Directors structure. He was chosen as Chairman and served as such for over 15 years. Ingvar Sodal said, "Stan is a very smart guy with a bent for detail. You can be sure that if Stan looks it over and you ask if it's OK, then it's OK. I've been impressed with his ability to express himself in writing, and that's a reflection of his clear thinking." Stan's concept is that "I like things to be complete, with no loose ends. No issue left unresolved." Melba Shepard said, "Stan's involvement with VAC has been invaluable. VAC probably would not exist without his continued support and genuine interest in the organization."

Stan danced frequently with the Denver folk dancers, with BIFD, and with Schukr in the park in summertime. In 1991 Stan met Sylvia Perchlik. "We met at a contradance. We've danced at Tea Dances, New Years Eve dances, the Waltz Balls in Fort Collins, and many special events. I like Stan because he dances and travels." Stan and Sylvia have traveled to six of the continents. Stan has long been a key volunteer with the International Festival

started by Anne Vickery. Anne says, "People don't recognize how much he has done for the organization."

VAC began to lease the Pearl Street Studio in 1992. Stan and Ingvar and Susan Jones became the managing partners in Folk Dancers Investment Group, LLC, which purchased the building in 1996. The Studio provides a secure home for several of the smaller dance groups in Boulder. The studio did not resolve the facility problems facing the larger groups. In 1998 the VAC Board responded to a solicitation from the City of Boulder to participate in a Civic Use facility downtown. Thus began a lengthy, expensive, frustrating, and ultimately futile effort. The upshot is that Chuck Palmer was drawn into participation with the VAC, eventually resulting in our Avalon Hall. "Chuck Palmer is a tremendous gift to VAC, and we need to not screw it up!" says Stan.

Stan is vitally interested in the future of the folk dance community, with particular emphasis on governance and facilities. "It is important that organizations with significant assets be governed by a small group of people. The most important asset for VAC is the Avalon. Leadership during the creation of VAC came from the folk dance community. The Avalon will serve a broader local community. Our leadership has to come from this broader community and from a younger generation. The VAC was formed with the goal of supporting the local dance groups. It is now important to make a way for future dance groups to succeed."

Stan Wilkes' steadfast vision of strong organizations, effective governance, correct financial records, and a secure home for dances has enriched and strengthened our local folk dance community. We are glad he is going strong and doing the things he most loves to do. All hail Stan Wilkes! Hear, hear!

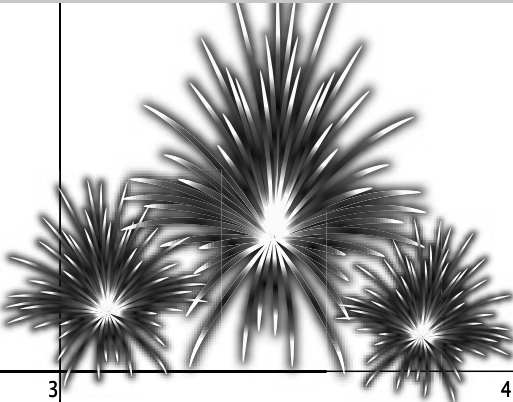
