

CFCZ continued...

The Colorado Friends of Cajun-Zydeco Music and Dance (CFCZ) was formed in 1997 when a spirited group of musicians and dancers wanted to present more Louisiana Cajun and zydeco bands to Colorado's Front Range. Though the nonprofit organization was officially incorporated on January 1, 1998, its roots run deeper than that, largely due to Meredith Carson, then Swallow Hill Concert Director, who organized a monthly dance series in 1993. In 1995, musician/benefactor Hugh Robertson further tested the waters by co-promoting two events with Swallow Hill featuring Balfa Toujours and the Savoy-Smith Band (Marc and Ann Savoy, with fiddler Ken Smith) at the Temple Events Center in Denver, CO. The response was ravenous and the success of both events affirmed the idea that a local nonprofit could promote Cajun and zydeco music/dance events in Colorado.

"The Mission of Colorado Friends of Cajun/Zydeco Music and Dance is to promote public understanding and awareness of Cajun & Creole culture within the State of Colorado, with a particular emphasis on Cajun and zydeco music and dance." Now rolling into its 14th year, CFCZ has hosted an average of five major events/year featuring top notch Louisiana talent, not an easy feat considering that the heart of French Louisiana is an 18-hour drive away. In 2009, CFCZ partnered with Alliance Française de Denver for a cultural exchange weekend with Creole musicians Preston Frank and Ed Poullard. The weekend consisted of accordion and fiddle workshops at Swallow Hill, a Creole French language seminar and evening concert at Alliance Française and a zydeco dance at the Mercury Café.

But hearing the music and witnessing other couples dance only goes so far. A half-hour before each event, CFCZ offers a complimentary dance lesson with the price of admission. Given the time constraint, the lesson is, at best, an introductory one, so periodically CFCZ arranges for nationally known instructors to teach longer lessons with more opportunity to practice with different partners.

So far in 2010, CFCZ has hosted a Mardi Gras show with the Creole Zydeco Farmers and held dances with Curley Taylor and Zydeco Trouble, Dikki Du and the Zydeco Krewe, and Dennis Stroughmatt and Creole Stomp. On Sunday, November 28, 2010, CFCZ will present the hard-hitting, sock-rocking Leroy Thomas and the Zydeco Roadrunners at the Mercury Café. Thomas is known for 'hits' of his own in the zydeco world such as "Bearilla," "Somebody's Looking For Ya" and "I Think I Need a Boosta." The dance starts at 2:00 p.m. with a complimentary dance lesson taught at 1:30 p.m. It will be a great way to wind down the Thanksgiving Weekend by shaking some tail feathers.

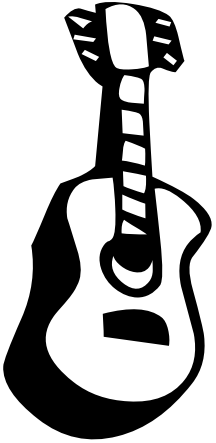

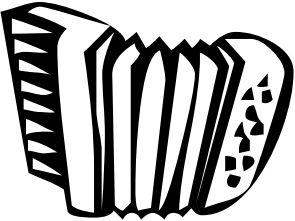

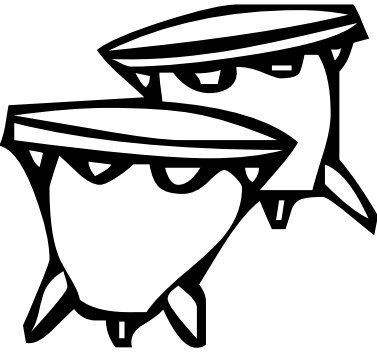
