Our Dance Community The Avalon Story

Overview

The Village Arts Coalition (VAC) was established in 1989 by a group of international folk dancers to support and promote the folk arts. Focus was on music and dance, including traditional costumes and musical instruments. The primary effort was to create a venue for dance, and to offer support for small groups engaged in recreational dance and public performance. The VAC is also the International Festival on the Pearl St.

Mall every year; and it is the Website and the STOMP! newsletter that brings us all together.

But the story begins long before that, in the early 1960s, when the international folk dancers were looking for a place to call home.

In the 1970s land was found and building materials were collected but the project failed because of personal problems. VAC still has

The Pearl Street Studio became available in 1991, was purchased in 1998, and most of the VAC groups started

dancing there.

The search for a larger, permanent dance space continued. Contra dancing was already popular when Jim Borzym came to Boulder in the mid-1980s and

became a popular caller. With his enthusiasm for vintage dancing, he was looking for good dance space. Chuck Palmer was active in the Contra Dance community. Ingvar Sodal was a VAC board member determined to pursue possibilities beyond the Pearl Street Studio. Stan Wilkes, VAC President, Chuck, Jim and Ingvar - three engineers and a CPA – became the VAC team for a building search.

VAC became hopeful once again with the St. Julian Hotel's civic space mandated by the City. Five years and more than \$100,000 were spent in an effort to create Skyloft, a ballroom and two additional spaces atop the Hotel's parking garage. Working with the City and a nonprofit that was to share the 37,000 square foot building, proved to be difficult and the entire project failed.

So in 2004 Ingvar, Chuck, Stan and Jim continued the search. An industrial building on East Arapahoe was up for sale. It seemed ideal with plenty of parking, tremendous amount of space with an excellent kitchen and spacious restrooms. The asking price was 3 million dollars. As the four deliberated, Chuck offered to provide the capital for buying the building!

Boulder Dance LLC was created to be the owner of this 31,000 square foot building with Chuck and VAC as the two

partners in the LLC -Chuck owning 99% and VAC 1%, VAC rents the Avalon Ballroom and the adjacent area from Boulder Dance. The remaining approximately 2/3 of the building is used for industrial rental space, thereby providing income for Boulder Dance. The LLC Operating Agreement and the rental agreement between VAC and Boulder

Dance allow VAC to receive all income from the dance spaces and Chuck receives tax benefits from the expenses. VAC applies this income to acquiring more shares in Boulder Dance LLC, which in turn uses this money to finish the ballroom and to build the additional dance spaces. VAC's ownership in Boulder Dance


has already increased to 6%. Eventually VAC will

become the sole owner of Boulder Dance.

Avalon Ballroom

The Avalon construction represents a remarkable project. With more than 15,000 hours of volunteer work tearing down cubicles and ceilings and constructing a floor, the Avalon Ballroom was built. With unfinished and rough decor, dance groups moved in immediately. We are all dancers – as long as there is good space, good floor, good music and good friends. The rest didn't matter. The Avalon Ballroom today is a lovely ballroom with an amazing dance floor.

Shown below is a schematic floor plan of the Avalon building with the current Ballroom Dance Floor, the Ballroom stage, the planned Sodal Dance Hall and the Alex Wilson Dance Studio. The Ballroom is 5,300 sq. ft. The Stage area is 740 sq. ft. and comfortably holds 20 musicians. Ceiling height is just over 13 ft.




Next Step

The planned Sodal Dance Hall is over 3,300 sq. ft. with a danceable area of 63' by 36' and a food or sitting area on one side (350 sq. ft.) The longest wall will be partially lined with mirrors that can be covered with drapes. The ceiling height is almost 12 feet.

The planned Alex Wilson Studio is almost 1,000 sq. ft. with mirrors and a mounted ballet bar.

The Cushioned Dance Floor - For all the dance spaces is red oak tongue and groove, 2 layers of plywood supported by 3/4 inch thick rubber cushioning pucks spaced in a 16 inch rectangular grid with each puck individually leveled to within 1/8 inch by a stack of 1/8 inch thick linoleum.



The Ballroom has over 3,000 cushioning pucks. Sodal Hall will have over 2,100 pucks and Wilson Studio 600 pucks.

Sound Insulating Walls - Each dance floor area is sound insulated by double walls. With the doors shut, people within one dance area should not be able to hear the other dance areas.

Volunteer Community of Dancers

Be part of this amazing volunteer effort and share the same vision that dancers had fifty years ago. The Avalon will not only be our dance home but it could grow and develop into the finest Ballroom in the West. Please join us in this exciting effort from actually building walls and floor to simpler tasks of clean-up, painting and decorating. What a sublime pleasure to dance on a floor and dance space that you helped to create and can feel some ownership through VAC membership.


