## The Plaza/Terrace Folkdancing

program started in the summer of 1982 at CU-Boulder's University Memorial Center Terrace. In 2000, we moved from the UMC Terrace to the outdoor Plaza beside the Dushanbe Teahouse, where this free summer Folkdancing program is still going strong.

The program has always been free, open to all regardless of experience, cultural origins, age or social status. It provides a wonderful opportunity for people to learn to dance, experience our cultural heritage, meet lots of great folks, and get into shape – all at the same time. Our summer program has introduced thousands of people to the joy of dance over the past 20+ years!

**This summer** we will be dancing every Tuesday evening, from June 5th until September 11th, outside on the Plaza next to the

Dushanbe Teahouse (1770 13th St., between Arapahoe and

Canyon) in Boulder. Instruction is from 7 to 8 p.m., and no partner or experience is needed. After instruction, the dancing continues until 10 p.m. There is also a children's dance program every other Tuesday (June 12, 26; July 10, 24; and August 7) from 6:15-7 p.m. It is free and open to all children, teens and their parents.
