The Lassion of Argentine Tango


Argentine Tango (not to be confused with ballroom tango) is known as a dance of emotion, passion and elegance. It is different than other dances. It comes with its own culture and becomes a passion and a way of life for some people. The well loved music is emotional and poetic and the dance is complex and mysterious, with the

partners sometimes dancing different moves and even dancing to different rhythms. A good embrace is vital and allows a nonverbal connection between the

> partners. This embrace/ connection allows

communication for the critical lead/follow interaction as well as filling the inherent human need for connection to another soul, making the dance deeply satisfying. The intention is to maintain a heart to heart connection and maximize the pleasure of your

partner. Dancing well requires knowing and feeling the music deeply and expressing musicality in the dance. Tango is an improvised dance, so each couple is doing its own dance, with the leader interpreting the music. It is entertaining just to watch. Argentine tango is actually three dances: tango, tango vals and milonga. They each have a different music and so some degree, moves.

Argentine Tango originated in the late 1800's in the poor neighborhoods of Buenos Aires. In the early twentieth century it was exported to Europe and North America. It caused such a stir in Europe that the Pope was asked to make a judgment on the appropriateness of the dance. Tango became acceptable to the polite classes in Argentina after it became a hit outside the country. Tango almost died out in the 1960s and 1970s, but was revived in the 1980's and has spread world wide since then. A dancer who knows the dance and the tango etiquette can attend a tango dance anywhere in the world, because language is not needed to ask for or accept an invitation to dance. This is done nonverbally by eye contact.

Argentine Tango is very popular, with classes, practices or dances occurring seven days a week in the Boulder/Denver area (often more than one event in a given day). There are two dances (called milongas) that occur at the Avalon. On most second Sundays (not December, though) there is a dance called Salón Avalon which features traditional tango music. Stay after Tea Dance and try it. On first, third and fifth Sundays there is Locotango para Todos, which has traditional tango music and non tango music. Both of these dances usually offer a free introductory lesson. To find out what is going on with Argentine Tango, visit the Tango Colorado website, www.tangocolorado.org. The calendar will list everything that is going on with this beautiful dance. Discover tango, be amazed and change your life.
