The first year was a bit rough although the children put forth maximum effort. They soon played their first dance at the Salberg Park shelter. Their tempos were wild, hambos and waltzes sounded the same, yet the dance community could not help being charmed by their enthusiasm, energy and colorful "fake" costumes. The community knew the young musicians would improve with time, and their faith kept the group going. Today it is alive and well. There are 17 current musicians who play guitar, violin, accordion, bass, nyckelharpa (keyed fiddle, a Swedish folk instrument), and Hardingfele (an 8-string Norwegian fiddle).

The Boulder Spelemannslag, affectionately known as Scando, has had many adventures over the years. The group has traveled to Lindsborg, Kansas, and played at several venues in Colorado. Individual members have attended camps in Mendocino, CA, Folklore Village, WI, and other centers throughout the U.S. Through the generosity of the Boulder Scandinavian Folk Dancers, the group has enjoyed private workshops with famed Swedish and Norwegian fiddlers, infusing them with beautiful new tunes and a greater understanding of the roots of the music. Once a month Ingvar and Sally Sodal give dance lessons to immerse them even more deeply into the culture. They look forward to these dance sessions and can be seen joining the adult dancers at events during the year.

Children can join the group around 4th or 5th grade and are members for life. Every year between Christmas and New Years, the annual Scando party brings together current members with alumni, including some of the group's original members. Clearly,

the Spelemannslag experience creates a profound and lasting bond. After visiting and sharing a potluck dinner, the group gathers around the potbelly stove at Kelly Barn. Everybody gets to request a tune, going round and round the circle, until they are exhausted from playing, visiting and laughing. Collectively, the group knows around 200 tunes -- all learned by ear, the traditional way of learning folk music.

Members of Scando rehearse weekly - a big commitment for kids who also have school and other extra-curricular activities. Several members of the group have been rewarded with university scholarships and gone on to become accomplished professional musicians. When the famous Tamburitzans folk ensemble from Duquesne University in Pittsburgh makes a performance stop in Boulder, it is likely that a past member of Scando will be on stage. Others have excelled in science, engineering and the arts. One student has made his own Hardingfele. Several have been to Scandinavia to attend festivals and workshops. One is now becoming quite accomplished in the Hardingfele performance having studied with some of the finest teachers. So in a small but continuous way, Scando is launching some of the next wave of folk musicians. In a time when there are fewer and fewer young folk dancers/musicians, it is heartening to see that leaving for college does not mean an end to their commitment and love of the folk genre.

There are many people to thank for help through the years. We won't list them all but Scando would like to say a special thanks to Mary Lou and Peter Van Laanan who have donated part of their house for the group's Wednesday rehearsals.


