

Maroon Bells Morris Dancers

Morris Dancing is an ancient English tradition of dance and music, which was in danger of passing into oblivion at the turn of the 19th century. Luckily, it was revived and survives today in many forms. These include Border Morris, from the border regions of England and Wales, Northwestern, Clogging, Rapper and Longsword.

Most common is the Cotswold style of Morris from the southern hills of England. This is the type of Morris dancing that has been performed by the Maroon Bells Morris Dancers in Colorado for more than 25 years now.

There are many traditions in Cotswold Morris, each distinctive to the small villages where they started. Usually, they involve waving white hankies or clashing sticks in intricate patterns, particular to the village of origin. Currently The Maroon Bells repertoire includes dances from the villages of Adderbury, Field Town, Acsof-Under-Wychwood and "Bampton-in-the-Bush."

Thought to bring good crops, fertility, luck and prosperity, the Morris has been performed by "sides"(or "teams") in almost every state in the continental USA, starting in the early 1970's. Each team usually wears white clothing, bells below the knees, and a distinguishing item that varies by team.

The Maroon Bells Morris Dancers have been featured on the Tonight Show and delivered merriment at fairs, festivals and gatherings since 1982. We are always looking for new performance venues or dancers.

Sally Ehrlich Hoffman, dancer and photographer, took her interest one step further by capturing dancing feet on film. "I started noticing what people did with their shoes and socks. Everybody had a different style and preference. So I photographed them." "Like all ballrooms, (the Spanish Ballroom) has a transient quality - and energy. I wanted to capture all the energy." She created clotheslines to display the passport-size photos of dancers' feet. The display is strung up against the back wall of the Spanish Ballroom in Glen Echo Park, Maryland. She trims each photo to just the outline of the shoes and ankles and encases it in heavy laminate. "Maybe people could wear a picture of their shoes around their necks as a sort of ID."
